The following LHMBB members and committee members are required to have an up-to-date Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) certificate:

- Musical Director of Junior Band;
- LHMBB Safeguarding Officer; and
- All adult LHMBB members who regularly assist with the Junior Band.

Changes and updates to the Safeguarding Policy are notified to LHMBB Members by the LHMBB Safeguarding Officer.
